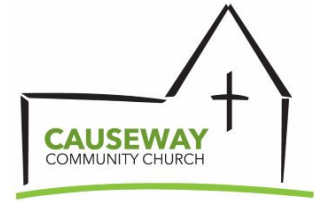

REFLECTION

QUESTIONS AND NOTES

- Read through Gal 1:1-10 and describe the intent and emotion of Paul and of those that would have first read it
 - Why is it so important to Paul?

1:1-2

- Why does Paul mention that he has not been sent by men or a man?
 - What is at stake?
- What is an apostle? Who are the apostles that wrote the bible? Why can we trust their record?

1:3-5

- How might you describe v3-5 to someone who has never heard the gospel before?
- What does it mean to be rescued from this present evil age? Particularly as we are still in this age?
 - You could look at 1 Tim 6:17; 2 Tim 4:10; 2 Cor 4:4 and Rom 12:2
 - How does belonging to a different age; being a new creation impact how we live?
- What do you notice about the description of God the father?
 - Why might that be mentioned in this context?

1:6-9

- What is Paul's great concern in these verses?
- Why is it that Paul can say that if he should preach another gospel he would be under a curse?
- What might tempt us to turn to another gospel?

1:10

- Paul has probably been called a 'people pleaser' because he was saying the gentiles did not need to be circumcised or keep the mosaic law to be fully accepted by God.
 - Why does he now say what he does in v10?
