

- Define what faith is

The issue v1

- Why is Paul so emotional? What is the issue?
- When is it right to have this sort of emotional reaction in the life of the church?
 - Do we have this sort of reaction? If not why not?

You were saved by faith v2-5

- In these verses Paul asks many rhetorical questions
 - Put each question into your own words
 - What point is Paul making?
- Why does Paul highlight the Spirit so much in these verses?
- How might remembering that we were saved by faith impact how we continue to live our lives?

People have always been saved by faith v6-9

- Why do you think Paul uses Abraham in his argument?
- What is Paul saying in these verses?
- What difference does it make to us now, knowing that people have always been declared righteous only by faith?

People have never been saved by works v10-12

- Paul quotes the old testament to show that people have never been saved by works. Take each statement at a time and try to follow the flow of Paul's argument.
- What does it mean to rely on the works of the law
 - How would we know if we were doing it?

Saved by faith in Jesus crucified v13-14

- What has Jesus redeemed us from?
- Jesus has redeemed for?
- What in v13-14 most excites us?
