QUESTIONS AND NOTES

- What are some of the variety of reasons why God gave us the law? What the law isn't for (v15-18)
 - What point is Paul making by using the image of a human contract?
 - What are the implications for us in how we read our bibles
 - What does Paul mean by the law?
 - What does Paul mean by the promise?
 - Look up Genesis 12:1-7; 13:14-15 and 15:4-6 to help
 - What does this mean for Abraham, Jesus and us (see Gal 3:29)
 - Why does Paul talk about Jesus being the seed?

Why then was the law given? (v19-25)

- What does Paul say is the purpose of the law in this passage?
- How do the images that Paul uses help us with this understanding?
- Look up Romans 3:20; 4:15 and 7:7 to see where else Paul explains the use of the law.
- Think of ways that we might misunderstand the law. What would be the impact of this?

Is the law opposed to the promise (v19-25)

- What is the law meant to do? (v22 and 24)
- How is this different to how others live their lives? Think of those that follow other religions or no religion at all
- How does this lead us to praise God?
