# **QUESTIONS AND NOTES**

- Paul says we are called to be free (5:13).
  - o Free from what?
  - o Free to do what?
  - What are we not free to do?
- How do we reconcile Paul's statement that we (Christians) are 'called to be free' with his comment to 'serve one another' (5:13)?
- What does Paul mean by 'the flesh (5:13, 24)?
  - Is he saying the body is inherently evil?
- Does Paul's list of the acts of the flesh have relevance to us (5:19-21)?
- What is the outcome of living to indulge/gratify the flesh (5:21)?
- What does 'serving one another humbly in love' look like in the life of a believer (5:13,22-23)?

- What does Paul mean when he says that the whole law is fulfilled in the command 'love your neighbour as yourself' (5:14)?
  - How do we harmonise this with Jesus summary of the law (Mark 12:29-31)?
- Paul says that Christians are not 'under the law' (5:18). What does he mean by this?
  - o Does that mean the law of Moses has no relevance for us?
- How do we ensure that we do not gratify the flesh (5:16)?
- Who is responsible for producing the 'fruit of the Spirit' (5:22-23; Phil 2:12-13)?
  - What are we called to do (5:24)?
- What is the implication for our lives day by day?
  - How do we live by/keep in step with the Spirit?
