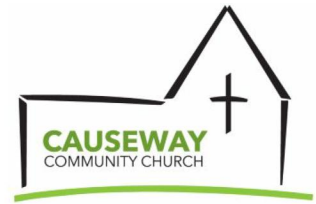


# MIGHTY GOD

## REFLECTION

### QUESTIONS AND NOTES

- What different views of God can people have?
  - How would this affect what they would think was happening when God came to earth?
- What would 'Mighty God' mean to the readers in Isaiah's time? (Isa 10:20-21; Deut 10:17; Ps 24:1-8; Ps 50:1-4; Gen 35:11-13)
  - What response might the people have hearing that Mighty God was coming to be born to them?
  - What impact does it have on us thinking of Jesus as being Mighty God?
- John 1 describes Jesus coming to us
  - Read 1:1-14, how is Jesus described as Mighty God in these verses?
  - How do we see Jesus is coming to us and as a human?
  - What reaction should we have to Mighty God becoming man and coming to us?
    - Why might we not react like this?
  - How do you think our friends who are not Christian would respond to these truths?
- Read Mark 4:35-41. How does this display Jesus as Mighty God?
- Read Mark 5:1-20. How does this display Jesus as Mighty God?

- Why did Mighty God come as a human?
  - Look in Isaiah 9 and John 1
